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
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Stormwater Management Plans (SWMP)

- * Every project has a SWMP and a ECP in the plan set
Both Over and Under an Acre
- * Every project will receive a SWMP Notebook which has some key submittals that need to be provided to complete the SWMP Notebook
- * There are some differences between Over and Under an Acre - CDPHE CDPs Permit (or EPA) and permit compliance as well as Monthly Audits by RWPCM
- * ESCAN is used for Monthly Audits Reports on Over an Acre projects
- * The SWMP and ECP are “living documents” and can be updated in the field to fit the conditions



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Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program

Purpose: Level the playing field for historically underutilized businesses

Overview

- Federal regulation requires that construction projects using FHWA funds be evaluated for DBE subcontracting goals.
- Goals are set by the Region Civil Rights office and based on factors specific to availability and construction needs.
- Contractors are required to make a commitment or demonstrate active and aggressive good faith efforts.

Forms and Submittals

Prime contractors bidding on CDOT jobs must submit a **Form 1414- Anticipated DBE Participation Plan** with their bid package. **Form 1416- Good Faith Effort Report**, **Form 1417- DBE Utilization Plan** is submitted in **B2Gnow** prior to award. After award, once contracts have been signed, the prime is required to submit one **Form 1432- Commercially Useful Function Questionnaire** for each DBE working toward the goal. The **Form 1420- DBE Participation Plan Modification Request** is submitted if the prime needs to change the utilization plan after contracts have been executed.

- CDOT Civil Rights Office can assist with the processes to submit all required forms.



On the Job Training (OJT) Program

- **“Developing the Workforce.”**
- The training special provision is an implementation of U.S.C. 140 (a) a federal requirement to provide equal opportunity and training on FHWA Federal Aid construction projects.
- Goals are set based on the criteria outlined in the 23 CFR Part 230, Appendix B to Subpart A.
- **Who can participate on a project?**
 - Prime and subcontractors
- **Types of OJT Plans:**
 - CDOT’s pre-approved classifications utilization program (PAC UP)
 - A registered U.S. Department of Labor training or apprenticeship program
 - Approved programs through Colorado Contractors Association (CCA), Western Colorado Contractors Association (WCCA), and/or workforce centers
- **Forms and Submittals**
 - 1337- Contractor Commitment to Meet OJT Requirements
 - 838- OJT Trainee/Apprentice Record
 - 832- Trainee Status Evaluation
- **CDOT OJT Manual was updated in 2024**





Scope of Work

- The document should be a stand-alone document
 - The document should tell the objective path
 - Information must reflect the specific tasks
 - The specific tasks must be assessed for risk
 - The risk of each specific task must be identified
 - Document mitigation measures for each risk



Scope of Work: A new Roundabout construction at SH 291 and Mesa Lane in Salida. Improvements include new sidewalk, curb & gutter, mill & overlay, drainage improvements, and landscaping. Two bid packages at Advertisement. Full improvements include 1/2 mile from Rush Drive to N. St. Large Federal Aid Local Agency Project.

Estimate: \$2 to \$6 million



Estimate: \$1 to \$3 million




25227 Ouray Main St. RMS

Scope of Work: Revitalizing Main Street grant project improving pedestrian connectivity in the City of Ouray. Two new RRFB Crossing with ADA sidewalk and ramp improvements on US 550 at both the Visitor Center and CR 361 (Ice Park). 800 LF of sidewalk, new curb and gutter, along with HMA shoulder paving existing gravel shoulders.

Estimate: \$0.5 to \$1 million




25281 Creede Main St. MMOF & RMS

Estimate: \$1 to \$3 million





Estimate: \$1-\$3 million




24699 US 50 & CO 291 ROUNDABOUT





