You are to remove the old tennis courts, grade the area, and install new ones.

The weather station needs to be kept running at all times.

We will be having a roofing project going on at the same time.

QUESTIONS:

Can we use school facilities? Power and water will be usable from outside sources. You will be in charge of your own restroom facilities.

Can concrete be poured into separate pores? Yes, the slabs can have different pores.

Was there a Geo-TEACH report done? Yes, will be added to the addendum if not already there.

Are backboards specked to a certain brand? We are open to substitutions for any product, but they must be approved by us first.

What is the time frame? Work is to start on Tuesday after Memorial Day and go to August 1st.

What color of landscaping rock do you want? Standard 1" We have not picked a color yet; we will add it to the addendum.

Please provide a breakdown or breakout of the price for the generator installation. Keep it separated on the plans and the bid.

Is the generator clearly separated on the plans? Yes.

We are providing the generator for the projects, and will make sure all generator information is on the addendum page if not in packed already.

Who is responsible for placing the generator in the school's selected spot? The contractor will set the generator in the spot. The Emery school district will provide the generator and have it at the school for the contractor

Do you require background checks on contractor employees? Yes, as to as far as what the state requires, but no additional checks.

Is there a limitation on work hours? No, it does get hot in the summer, so we know night pores might be needed.

Power will come straight out of the top of the building

Who keeps the temporary power running to the weather station? Emery County School District

There is water running around the building and a fiber-optic wire. There is a marker by the fence, walking up to the tennis courts, and running beside the dumpster.

Who is responsible for locating utilities? Emery Country School will mark or have the utility marked for the job site.

Do contractors need to get building permits from Green River City? No, it is all handled in-house

Who does soil testing/ concrete testing/compaction testing? District will pay they use Johansen and Tuttle, and are open to other suggestions if you have someone you like better.

You will have full access to the back parking lot during construction.

We will be using Galvinize fencing

A Certified tennis builder needs to be on staff for this build
