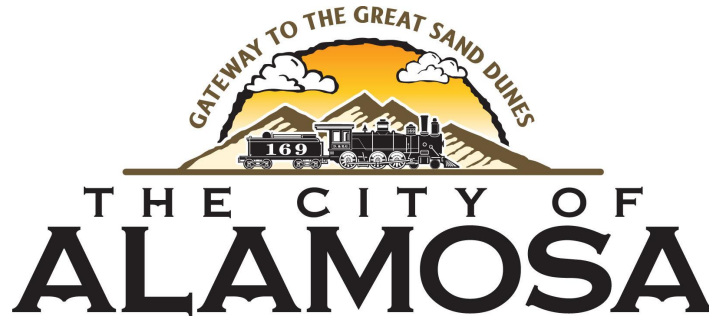




REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

Debris and Rubbish Removal Services

Advertisement Date: June 15th, 2026

Question Deadline: July 6th, 2026

Submittal Deadline: 4:00 p.m. MST, July 13th, 2026

1. Introduction and Purpose

The City of Alamosa is seeking proposals from qualified and experienced contractors to provide comprehensive cleanup and removal services for rubbish, trash, and debris. This service is required for maintaining public safety and ensuring the prompt disposal of materials resulting from incidents, enforcement actions, or general public nuisance.

2. Scope of Work (SOW)

The selected contractor shall provide all necessary labor, equipment, transportation, and proper disposal of collected materials. Services required include, but are not limited to:

- **General Cleanup:** Routine removal of general rubbish, trash, and accumulated debris from public areas identified by the City.
- **Incident Response:** On-call, expedited cleanup of debris resulting from illegal dumping, illegal camping and disposal of abandoned property.
- **Material Handling:** Handling and disposal of various materials, which may include bulk trash, household goods, construction debris, tires, and in some cases, potentially hazardous items such as animal/human waste, drug paraphernalia, animal carcasses, etc.
- **Compliance:** All materials must be disposed of legally and responsibly in compliance with all local, state, and federal regulations. The contractor must provide disposal manifests upon request.
- **Equipment:** Contractor must maintain and utilize reliable vehicles and equipment suitable for the safe collection and transportation of varied debris volumes.

3. Period of Performance

The initial contract term will be for twelve (12) months, commencing on July 20th, 2026. With agreement of the Contractor, the Police Department may renew the contract based upon the same terms and conditions for up to two (2) additional one-year periods.

4. Proposal Submission Requirements

To be considered for this contract, all proposals must include the following information:

1. Contractor Overview:

- Company name, address, and primary contact information.
- Description of relevant experience, particularly similar cleanup contracts with municipal or government entities.
- Proof of liability insurance.

2. Proposed Services Plan:

- Description of available personnel and equipment.
- Proposed response time for emergency/on-call requests (e.g., within 24 hours).

3. Pricing Schedule:

- A clear breakdown of costs. Proposers may provide an hourly rate for labor and equipment, a flat rate for specific common cleanup tasks, or a proposed monthly retainer/fee, detailing what is included in the cost.

5. Proposal Evaluation Criteria

Proposals will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- **Experience and Qualifications (40%):** Demonstrated ability and history of successful debris removal.
- **Cost/Pricing (40%):** Competitiveness and clarity of the proposed pricing structure.
- **Availability and Response Time (20%):** Ability to meet routine schedules and provide prompt service for emergency calls.
